


Operation




This unit's strobe illuminator operates at the AC line frequency which generally has a 0.2% fluctuation. This fluctuation, when present, may make the strobe pattern appear to change. However, actual platter speed does not change, because the DC motor is not affected by AC power line frequency.

Notes:


- Do not try to clean the dust cover while a disc is playing, because static electricity might cause the tonearm to rise.
- The unit is in the standby condition when the AC power supply cord is connected. The primary circuit is always "live" as long as the power cord is connected to an electrical outlet.




1. The tonearm will automatically return to the arm rest (the automatic return feature).

Suggestions for Safety

■ Use a standard electrical AC wall outlet

1. Use from an AC power source of high voltage, such as for air conditioners, is very dangerous.

Be extremely careful not to make a connection to the electrical outlet for a large air conditioner or central-heating unit which uses high voltage, because there is the possibility of fire.

2. A DC power source cannot be used.


If, during operation, the sound is interrupted or indicators no longer illuminate, or if abnormal odor or smoke is detected, immediately disconnect the power cord plug, and contact your dealer or an Authorized Service Center.

Adjustment

Adjustment of the automatic-return position

Make this adjustment if the tonearm doesn't return automatically to the arm rest, or if it returns before the tune ends.


1. Adjust to the desired automatic-return position.
2. Check to be sure the automatic-return position is correct.



Adjustment of the stylus-to-disc clearance

This adjustment is preset at the factory for standard "P-mount" cartridges. This adjustment should not be necessary unless a nonstandard cartridge or stylus is used.

1. Set the cueing control to "V".
2. Move the tonearm to a position above the disc.
3. Adjust the stylus tip position.



Adjustment of the platter speed

When the platter rotates, the strobe marks form a stripe pattern according to the rotation speed and the frequency of the power supply.

The platter speed is correct when the stripe pattern of the stroboscope appears to be stationary while the platter is moving; adjust the speed if the stripes appear to be moving.

Speed	Power supply frequency
45 rpm	for 50 Hz use
33-1/3 rpm	(For European countries)
45 rpm	for 60 Hz use
33-1/3 rpm	(For U.S.A. and CANADA)

If stripe pattern seems to move to the left (platter speed is too fast)

Platter speed will decrease.



Replacement

Note: Before replacing the cartridge and stylus, disconnect the AC power supply cord.

Replacement of the cartridge

The plug-in type of cartridge is already designed to match this unit in every respect: weight, correct stylus pressure, stylus tip position, center of gravity, etc. This means that there's no longer any need for troublesome connection of lead wires or adjustment of the stylus pressure.




Replacement of the stylus

If noise is heard from new discs, the stylus is probably worn. Replace it with a new one.

- Stylus life..... approx. 1000 hours
- New stylus..... EPS-34CS




Maintenance

To clean dust from the stylus

Use a soft brush or similar material to gently remove the dust.

Thoroughly clean your discs occasionally with a high-quality disc cleaner.



Maintenance of external surfaces

To clean this unit, use a soft, dry cloth.

If the surfaces are extremely dirty, use a soft cloth, dipped into a soap-and-water solution or a weak detergent solution.

Wring the cloth well before wiping the unit.

Wipe once again with a soft, dry cloth.

Never use alcohol, paint thinner, benzene, nor a chemically treated cloth to clean this unit.

Such chemicals may damage the finish of your unit.
